Change in Shower Services

Hope's Corner is ending shower services for the month of June and will reassess at a later date. In the meantime, Dignity on Wheels is still available for showers and laundry services on Tuesdays at CSA (240 Stierlin Rd., Mountain View) from 1 – 5 p.m. and **new on Thursdays from 9 a.m. – 1 p.m.** See attached table on other times and locations for showers in the Bay Area.

More Mobile Testing is On the Way

The City of Mountain View is working with Santa Clara County to set up more testing sites for our area. We will be sending out flyers when more dates and times are available. You may also go to any of the County's free testing sites by going online to SCCFreeTest.org and looking what the closest testing location is for you.

- You should be tested for COVID-19 within 3-5 days of being near or with a group of people that you normally do not spend time with
- Testing is free and confidential
- You will NOT be asked your immigration status and it will NOT impact your immigration status
- You do not need any documentation, insurance or doctor's note
- Results within 5 days by phone call and a letter to follow up

Safe Parking Reminder

Safe Parking is currently 24/7 at Shoreline and Evelyn lots and at any church lots. To participate, you need to register through the Community Services Agency (CSA).

Los servicios durante la crisis de COVID-19 estarán disponibles los siguientes días:

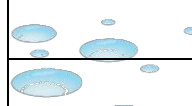
