Student Learning Outcomes:

Students are all taking courses from different disciplines online. However general learning outcomes include the following.

- Students will become independent learners, with weekly prompting and guidance from the teacher.
- Students will become effective time managers.
- Students will complete the course(s) as either graduation requirements or electives.

Assessment and Grading ([BP 5121](#) / [AR 5121](#)): To ensure that every student has an equal opportunity to demonstrate their learning, the course instructors implement aligned grading practices and common assessments with the same frequency.

1. Grading categories and their percentage weights:
 - a. All courses are different and therefore weighted differently. However, it is expected that students complete at least five to six percent of the course weekly.
 - b. Students who wish to work at a rapid, independent pace are encouraged to do so, as long as they maintain good grades (C or better) in their individual classes.
2. Achievement evidence collected within each grading category:
 - a. Measurements reported in the SIS gradebook are not grades. They reflect the percentage of curriculum the student has completed to date.
3. Grading scales:
 - a. 90 - 100 % = "A"
 - b. 80 - 89% = "B"
 - c. 70 - 79% = "C"
 - d. 60 - 69% = "D"
 - e. Below 60 % = "F"
4. Homework/outside of class practices ([AR 6154](#)):
 - a. All work is to be done as independent study.
 - b. Students MUST see the teacher every Monday for a progress check and to have any questions answered.
5. Excused absence make up practices ([Education Code 48205\(b\)](#)):

Students can make up their work independently. The software is available to students from any Internet connected computer on or off campus.
