RACE MAP 2024

START- Begin at the main turf field near the scoreboard.

- Run straight towards the high jump pit, then veer left.
- Continue onto the track, pass the finish line, and head towards the baseball field.
- Proceed straight past the portables, then turn right onto the baseball field.
- Veer left, sticking to the grass area only.
- Run along the outer grass area of the infield towards the fence.
- Follow the fence line, exit through the gate, and turn left towards the tennis courts.
- Run along the lacrosse field towards the east driveway of the tennis courts.

- Turn right at the softball bleachers, then head towards the grass field.
- Turn right towards the softball grass field, run towards the scoreboard, and turn left to follow the fence line towards the Turf Lacrosse Field.
- Turn right onto the Lacrosse Field and continue along the tennis courts turn right.
- Make a left turn towards the exit gate.
- Straight ahead, run between the stadium and the 700 building towards the front of the school.
- Turn left at the loop, and run along the loop to the sidewalk.
- Follow the sidewalk, then turn right into the second driveway of the parking lot.
- Run through the marked aisle, then turn left towards the track.
- Turn right onto the track, and run the entire first portion of the race again.
- The third time on the track will lead you to the finish line in the Eagle Tunnel.
