# When can students see their counselor?

Students may drop in at their counselor's office during brunch or lunch, or can make an appointment during ACT

#### What do school counselors do?

School counselors are part of your student's support "village" during their 4 years @ LAHS

- Help them make a plan for graduation and postsecondary plans (college, work, etc)
- Assist them in selecting classes every year

#### Impact of Grades

**Credits** & **graduation** status

**Eligibility** for LAHS athletics

Grades are important, but remember to encourage a focus on effort & building strong academic habits/skills

#### What are credits?

- Units earned for passing a course
- Every class earns 5 credits each class per semester
- Required for graduation
- This is new for most students coming from middle school
